### **POLAR BEARS SUMMER LEAVING CONCERT - FRIDAY 15<sup>th</sup> JULY 6.15PM**

Keeping with Teddy Bears tradition, the Polar Bears school leavers will be putting on a summer performance for their parents. This event will be held outside on the playground but may only be attended by two family members per child. You will receive more details of this event nearer the time but please ask Sam or Helen if you do have any questions.

### **IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER**

### **WHATS GOING ON IN THE CLASSROOM**

**Panda Bears-** This group will be exploring transport, with stories & rhymes a trip to watch the trains & lots of creative activities with wheels & paint!

**Sunshine Bears-** These children will be looking at the story 'Dig, dig, Digging', identifying the different modes of transport, creating the noises they make through songs & rhymes. There will be trips to the bridge to watch trains as well as a traffic survey from our carpark where the children can identify a variety of transport. Pointing out transport & discussing it with your child on the way to & from nursery would support their learning.

**Koala Bears** – This group is continuing with the royal theme & will be looking at London landmarks creating their own bridges, palaces & castles. They will be making flags & listening to band music aiming to create their own. Encouraging your child to share any Jubilee celebrations they experience with us would be beneficial.

**Polar Bears-** This group are using the story the '3 Billy goats gruff, where they will be sequencing the events of the story & discussing the characters. Recognizing & recording the numbers 1,2,3 will be an aim too. There will be lots of bridge building using various resources, as well as acting out the story with puppets & props. Discussing this story at home with your child would be beneficial to their learning.

**Polar Bears-** These children will be taking the story of the ‘3 Billy goats gruff’ outside. There will be lots of role play as they trip trap over the bridge as well as creating their own bridges from bricks.
